- Building: Players can spend money to build new buildings in the city.

- **150 cards** (representing events, laws, and characters)
- Money
- Dice


There are currently two expansions available for Fortune Favorites Masters Of Rome:



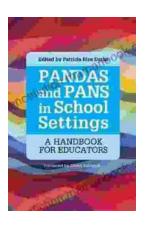
