- 3. Row 7-28: Rep Rows 2-6.
- 4. Row 29: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st until the last 21 sts, ch 1, skip 21 sts, sc in each st across. (57 sc)
- 5. **Row 30-35:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across. (57 sc)

Part 3: Assembly

- 1. **Shoulder Seams:** With right sides together, sl st the first 29 sts of the back panel to the first 29 sts of the right front panel. Rep on the other side.
- 2. **Side Seams:** With right sides together, sl st the remaining sts of the back panel to the remaining sts of the left front panel. Rep on the other side.
- 3. **Sleeves:** Join yarn at the underarm of the left front panel and ch 3. So in the same st and each st around until you reach the underarm of the right front panel. Sl st to join.
- 4. **Hood:** Join yarn at the back neck of the vest and ch 3. Sc in the same st and each st around until you reach the back neck again. Sl st to join.
- 5. **Collar:** Join yarn at the front neck of the vest and ch 3. Sc in the same st and each st around until you reach the back neck. Sl st to join.
- 6. **Finishing Touches:** Weave in all loose ends and block your vest to shape.

Tips and Variations

- Yarn Choice: For a lightweight and airy vest, consider using a cotton or bamboo yarn. For extra warmth, choose a wool or acrylic blend.




