- US size 8 knitting needles
- Yarn needle

Gauge

4 stitches per inch in stockinette stitch

Difficulty Level

Beginner

Instructions

Size Preemie

1. Cast on 20 stitches.
2. Knit every row until the piece measures 12 inches.
3. Bind off all stitches.

Size Newborn

1. Cast on 24 stitches.
2. Knit every row until the piece measures 14 inches.
3. Bind off all stitches.

Size Doll

1. Cast on 16 stitches.

2. Knit every row until the piece measures 10 inches.
3. Bind off all stitches.

Finishing

1. Fold the piece in half lengthwise, right sides together.
2. Sew the sides together, leaving a 2-inch opening at the bottom for turning.
3. Turn the cocoon right side out and weave in any loose ends.
4. Insert a ribbon or tie at the top of the cocoon to secure it around your little one's neck.

Tips

- If you are using a different weight yarn, you may need to adjust the number of stitches you cast on.
- You can also adjust the length of the cocoon by knitting more or less rows.
- To make the cocoon even more cozy, you can line it with a soft fabric.

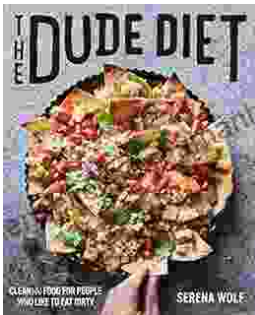

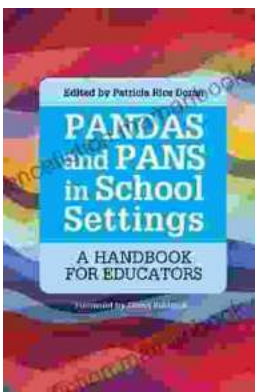
