- Cable needle (optional)
- Stitch markers
- Tapestry needle

Abbreviations Used

- K: Knit
- P: Purl
- Sts: Stitches
- C4F: Cable 4 front
- C4B: Cable 4 back
- Sl 1, K1, PSSO: Slip 1, knit 1, pass slipped stitch over

Baby Dress Pattern

Size: 3 Months

Measurements:

- Chest circumference: 16 inches
- Length: 12 inches

Instructions:

Back Panel

1. Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 80 sts.
2. Row 1: K2, *P2, K2; repeat from * to the end of the row.
3. Rows 2-12: Repeat Row 1.
4. Rows 13-15: K all sts.
5. Row 16: *C4F, K2; repeat from * to the last 8 sts, K8.
6. Rows 17-19: K all sts.
7. Rows 20-22: Repeat Row 16.
8. Rows 23-25: K all sts.
9. Rows 26-28: Repeat Row 16.
10. Rows 29-31: K all sts.
11. Rows 32-34: Repeat Row 16.
12. Rows 35-37: K all sts.
13. Rows 38-40: Repeat Row 16.
14. Rows 41-43: K all sts.
15. Rows 44-46: Repeat Row 16.
16. Rows 47-59: K all sts.
17. Row 60: *C4B, K2; repeat from * to the last 8 sts, K8.
18. Rows 61-63: K all sts.
19. Rows 64-66: Repeat Row 60.
20. Rows 67-69: K all sts.

21. Rows 70-72: Repeat Row 60.
22. Rows 73-75: K all sts.
23. Rows 76-78: Repeat Row 60.
24. Rows 79-83: K all sts.
25. Row 84: *K2, P2; repeat from * to the end of the row.
26. Rows 85-95: Repeat Row 84.
27. Bind off all sts.

Front Panel

1. Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 80 sts.
2. Row 1: K2, *P2, K2; repeat from * to the end of the row.
3. Rows 2-12: Repeat Row 1.
4. Rows 13-15: K all sts.
5. Row 16: *K2, C4B; repeat from * to the last 8 sts, K8.
6. Rows 17-19: K all sts.
7. Rows 20-22: Repeat Row 16.
8. Rows 23-25: K all sts.
9. Rows 26-28: Repeat Row 16.
10. Rows 29-31: K all sts.
11. Rows 32-34: Repeat Row 16.
12. Rows 35-37: K all sts.

13. Rows 38-40: Repeat Row 16.
14. Rows 41-43: K all sts.
15. Rows 44-46: Repeat Row 16.
16. Rows 47-59: K all sts.
17. Row 60: *K8, C4F; repeat from * to the last 2 sts, K2.
18. Rows 61-63: K all sts.
19. Rows 64-66: Repeat Row 60.
20. Rows 67-69: K all sts.
21. Rows 70-72: Repeat Row 60.
22. Rows 73-75: K all sts.
23. Rows 76-78: Repeat Row 60.
24. Rows 79-83: K all sts.
25. Row 84: *P2, K2; repeat from * to the end of the row.
26. Rows 85-95: Repeat Row 84.
27. Bind off all sts.

Sleeves

1. Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 30 sts.
2. Row 1: K2, *P2, K2; repeat from * to the last 4 sts, K4.
3. Rows 2-10: Repeat Row 1.
4. Rows 11-13: K all sts.

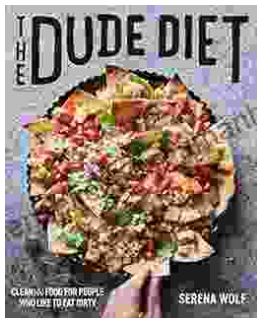
5. Row 14: *C4F, K2; repeat from * to the last

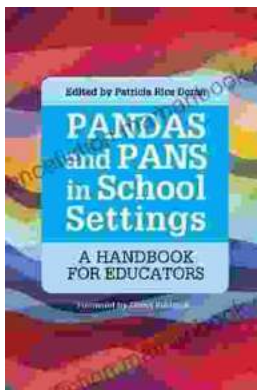
