# Life Beyond Prison Walls: Barz Bruisez's Journey from Inmate to Advocate





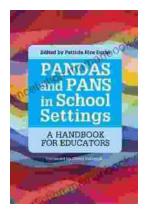
