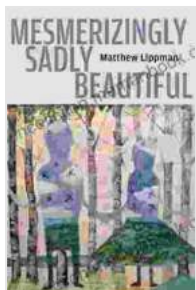


The Mesmerizingly Sad and Beautiful Four-Way Levis Prize in Poetry

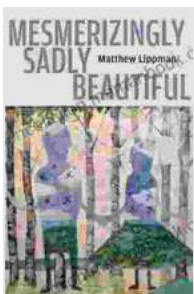

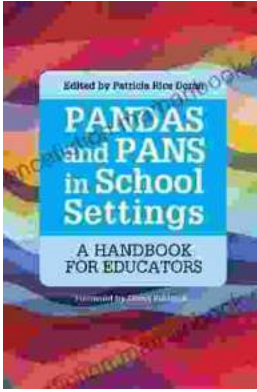
